The next week I brought a Bible on MP3 for the sister since she can't read and look forward to how this story continues.

COMING UP! Next week I will start English courses in the daytime for children. Also I have a team coming from America that is partnering with us (Global Hope) for 10 days. Voice of the Martyrs has donated 150 action packs for us to give out to families so that means a lot of fun and a lot of house visits. I am so stoked. My friend, Kara, is coming in that team and will stay with me for 7 weeks to co-work together here. There is so much to say about life in this lovely nation and what God is doing,,,,,but hey we're up to 2 pages already!
